



After graduating from Galatasaray High School in 1980, Professor Günay Anlaş received his undergraduate degree from the Department of Mechanical Engineering at Middle East Technical University in 1985, his master's degree from the Department of Mechanical Engineering at Texas Tech University in 1988, and his doctorate from the Department of Mechanical Engineering at the University of Delaware in 1992. Professor Anlaş has been a faculty member in the Mechanical Engineering Department of Boğaziçi University since 1992. He served as the Head of the Mechanical Engineering Department between 2004-2016 and as the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering between 2015-2021. Professor Anlaş has been a visiting researcher at Illinois, Virginia Tech, and Delaware universities. He gave short lectures at École Nationale Supérieure de Techniques Avancées, Paris, and Northwestern Polytechnical University in China and collaborated with researchers in the USA, France, Australia, and China. Professor Anlaş's fields of expertise can be listed as mechanics, automotive engineering, and renewable energy. He has advised more than 60 graduate students. He has worked in commissions for many years on engineering education and assessment and prepared reports for the Accreditation Board of Engineering and Technology (ABET) and the Turkish Engineering Dean's Council (MDK). Professor Anlaş has been acting as the Secretary-General of MDK since 2018.
